About the Speaker: Dr. Manan Dwivedi is an Assistant Professor in Indian Institute of Public Administration (IIPA). He trains Senior Officers of both Civil and Defence Services in the discipline of International Relations and International Organizations. He is a Visiting Faculty at Foreign Service Institute (FSI), Ministry of External Affairs and Indian Society of International Law (ISIL), various Central and Private Universities.

Dr. Dwivedi has taught themes of the order of "Introduction to Political Science", Western and Indian Political thought, Comparative Political Analysis, Ideologies and Indian Political System and dealt with "International Organizations" and "International Relations" in the Gujarat National Law University. He also has taught the course, "Internal Security in India" to Mphil/PhD students in the Central University Gujarat, Gandhinagar.
