Nithya Nagarajan has in-depth international trade law and international trade consulting experience with United States trade issues, as well as legal expertise related to international trade issues in China and India. Her experience extends to all levels of antidumping duty law and countervailing duty law proceedings in the United States and in several other countries. Nithya has led and participated in numerous trade remedy proceedings conducted by the U.S. Department of Commerce (DOC), the Ministry of Commerce in the People's Republic of China, and the European Commission.

She has worked for the U.S. government in various trade remedy enforcement agencies. Nithya has also negotiated several bi-lateral trade agreements (suspension agreement or undertakings) on behalf of the DOC in the settlement of antidumping duty investigations. She is a Gold and Bronze Medal Recipient for her work on various steel cases during her tenure at the Department of Commerce. Nithya led several on-site verifications of companies throughout the world including, Russia, Ukraine, Japan.

Before starting her own practice, Nithya worked as an attorney in the Office of Chief Counsel for Import Administration at the DOC providing legal advice to the Import Administration in the conduct of antidumping and countervailing duty investigations and reviews. Nithya has represented the United States in litigation before the U.S. Court of International Trade, the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit, and the Dispute Settlement Body at the WTO.
