On the occasion of the International Day of Persons with Disabilities, a groundbreaking Disability Media Toolkit was launched at India Gate, symbolizing a significant step towards fostering inclusive and sensitive media representation of persons with disabilities (PwDs).

This initiative was the result of months of dedicated effort by five final-year students of JSJC under the mentorship of Professor and Dean Kishalay Bhattacharjee, in collaboration with the National Centre for Promotion of Employment for Disabled People (NCPEDP).

Journalism students Moksh Dhand, Muskan Kaur, Sheikha Mariyam Sam, Shreya Saksena and Uddantika Kashyap undertook this project, which involved months of rigorous research, surveys, and interviews with PwDs. The result was the culmination of all this research into a toolkit, designed to assist journalists in portraying disability narratives with respect and authenticity.
