

JGU team makes the nation proud at Vienna

The negotiating team comprising Anshul Kumar Sarma, Pankhuri Gupta, Akshat Jha, and Swara Popat, represented JGU in Vienna, Austria, from 7-12 July, at The IBA-VIAC CDRC Vienna - The Mediation and Negotiation Competition 2023, one of the biggest and most prestigious ADR Competitions.

The team was selected to participate at CDRC after an extremely competitive application process, as one of only 24 negotiating teams from a pool of applicant teams from around the world. Their performance at the competition was recognised with the award for the 'Best Negotiation and Mediation Strategy'.

This is the third time in nine editions that a team from JGU has been selected to participate. They are the only Indian negotiating team to have won an award at the competition. The team was coached by Mr. AJ Jawad, a professional mediator in India. Mr. Umar Safras, a postgraduate law student from Sri Lanka, also helped them.
