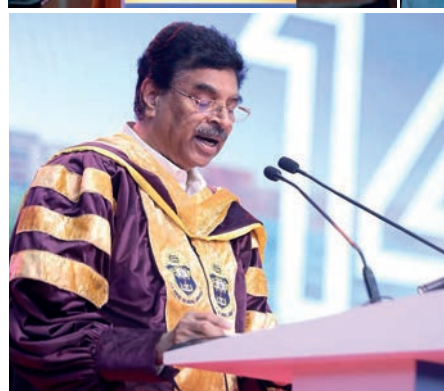

stage a remarkable 12 times, ensuring that every gathering was infused with melody and energy.

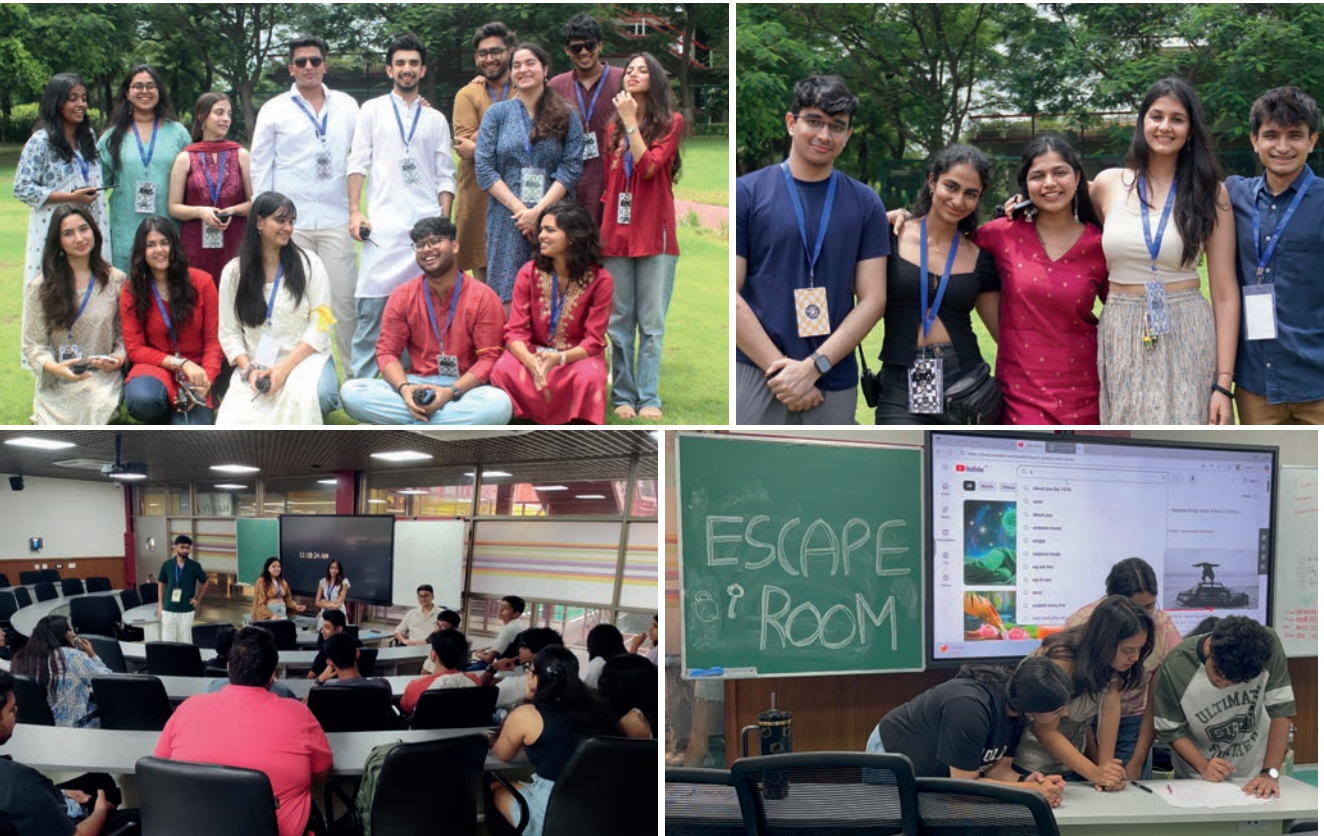
From the melodious rendition of *Vande Mataram* to the National Anthem *Jana Gana Mana*, the ceremony turned into a festival of togetherness.
