Mr. Mukesh Bhatnagar is a Professor at the Centre for WTO Studies, Indian Institute of Foreign Trade (IIFT), New Delhi. He has 30 years of experience in international trade issues, including trade remedies and WTO Dispute Settlement.

During 2007-12 he worked in the Trade Policy Division of the Department of Commerce, Government of India as Director and Additional Director General of Foreign Trade where he handled Rules Negotiation and WTO Disputes. he also handled bilateral FTAs with several important trading partners including EU, ASEAN, Japan, Korea, Israel, New Zealand. During the 2001-06 he worked as Director in the Directorate General of Anti-dumping and Allied Duties (DGAD) where he handled about 30 cases of anti-dumping investigations including changed circumstances reviews and sunset reviews. He was also associated in the Rules negotiations of the Doha Round and took part in the meetings of the Negotiating Group on Rules (NGR).

He has a MBA from University of Hull, UK and he did his graduation in B.Com (Hons.) from Delhi University. He had joined the Indian Trade Service in 1984 and worked in different offices of Directorate General of Foreign Trade (DGFT) for about 20 years.
