## **European Union's Foreign Policy and its External Action Service**

Pavel Svítíl holds a doctoral degree in international relations. He started his professional career at the Czechoslovak Ministry of Foreign Affairs in 1985. As a Czech Diplomat he was posted at the Embassies in Poland and as Deputy Head in Slovenia. From 1998 he dealt with the accession of the Czech Republic to the EU, also as Acting Secretary of the Czech Negotiating Team and from 2000 as Deputy Head of the Czech Embassy to Cyprus. After entry of the Czech Republic to the EU in 2004 he became Czech National Coordinator of the Stability Pact for South Eastern Europe and Member of the Governing Board of European Agency for Reconstruction. He was dealing with South Eastern Europe and EU enlargement policy during the Czech Presidency in the Council of the EU in the first half of 2009. In 2010 he became Deputy Head of the Delegation of the European Union to India and Bhutan.
