Mario de Zamaroczy, an economist, is an Advisor in the African Department of the International Monetary Fund (IMF) in Washington, DC. Prior to joining the IMF, he worked for the French Foreign Ministry on multilateral issues. His career at the IMF has spanned thirty years and five departments, including the African, Asian, and Eastern Europe departments. He was posted abroad in Cambodia as resident representative in 2000, and in Tanzania as the Director of the IMF's East Africa Region Technical Assistance Center in 2007. He helped spearhead an internal reform of the IMF's technical assistance program, which led to the establishment of several regional technical assistance centers. His experience as mission chief has covered several countries on three continents, including recent tours covering Benin, Cameroon, the Democratic Republic of the Congo, and currently Angola. His economic interests include highly dollarized economies and the management of international reserves. He is an alumnus of the *Université de Paris*; *l'Institut de Sciences Politiques de Paris*; *l'École Supérieure des Sciences Économiques et Commerciales*; and *l'École Nationale d'Administration*, all located in Paris, France.
