Who should attend the MA in Business Laws programme of Jindal Global Law School?

- 1) Business professionals who do not possess an LLB degree (and therefore cannot proceed directly to an LLM), who nevertheless need a solid grounding in Business Laws to advance in their careers in the legal, tax, accounting, banking insurance and corporate finance domains.
- 2) Experienced senior executives, government official, senior partners, entrepreneurs – for example in other management fields such as medicine, healthcare, public administration, government department, higher education, journalism, engineering and management consulting.
- 3) Those practitioner-scholars who simply want to embark on a rigorous, highly selective, world-class journey of continuous self-improvement and acquire a wider knowledge base and personal network with academic accreditation and an international reputation for excellence.

Entrance requirements: will include a good undergraduate degree in any rigorous subject with academic and professional references where appropriate. The initial intake of Master of Business Laws students is intended as an exclusive cohort of non-law professionals not exceeding 40 – an early application in 2018 is therefore advised so as to avoid missing out on this unique opportunity. Corporate nominees backed by their organisations are highly encouraged to apply for admission among this founding world-class batch of highly qualified and motivated professionals. The selection process will be based on an entrance exam and a personal interview.

Eligibility and Fees

Two Year M.A. in Business Laws Programme

- **Eligibility:** Bachelor's degree in any subject with not less than 50% aggregate marks.
- **Entrance Exam - JGLS Masters in Business Laws Admission Test and Personal Interview.**
- **Programme Fee:** ₹ 3,00,000 per year
- **Number of seats:** Seats are limited to 40 only.
- **Admission Process:** The candidates for admission to the Two Year M.A. in Business Laws Programme at Jindal Global Law School will be selected on the basis of nomination by their employers and on the basis of their

online application to the M.A. in Business Laws Programme Office subject to fulfilment of eligibility.
