O.P. Jindal Global University (JGU) is dedicated to public service and to support and facilitate a holistic ethical organisational culture, the University has appointed a Chief Compliance Officer who is responsible for all matters related to ethical, statutory and regulatory compliance of the University. Professor Nitesh Bansal is the Chief Compliance Officer (CCO) of the University https://jgu.edu.in/chief-compliance-officer/

As the Chief Compliance Officer, he works closely with Deans, Directors, and Heads of various Administrative Units towards fulfilment of mission of the University.

He also works closely with the Chairperson of The Research Ethics Review Board (RERB) (https://jgu.edu.in/odr/rerb/) which was established by O.P. Jindal Global University to deal with various ethical issues and questions that arise from conducting research with a view to ensure that the research projects developed conform to global standards of ethical guidelines.

The RERB has set out guidelines which provide a framework for researchers to engage deeply and critically with the ethical questions arising out of their research, both theoretically and empirically when engaging with human subjects. An application must be submitted to the RERB 6 weeks before the commencement of the research project. The RERB, after completing it's 3-tier review process, will respond expeditiously to the applicants. The Applicants must ensure that the research follows the guidelines of the RERB and conforms to global standards relating to the question of ethics in research.
