



O.P. Jindal Global University's efforts towards creating a disability-friendly campus:

The Disability Support Committee:

JGU endeavours to harness an inclusive learning environment for all its students. Students with a known disability, requiring different academic and other accommodations are required to register with the Disability Support Committee (DSC). The Committee provides a range of accommodations to the conditions identified by the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, Mental Health Care Act 2017 and UGC Guidelines. We provide support to students with a wide range of health and learning related conditions. These conditions include physical and movement-related difficulties, visual impairment, hearing impairment, medical conditions, specific learning difficulties and mental health conditions. The Disability Support Committee maintains strict confidentiality in its discussions and respects the privacy of the students.

O2 Academic Support:

Students with specific learning disabilities were referred to the Academic Development and Planning Mentor (ADPM) for additional support. The counsellors recommend academic mentors for specific students who face difficulty in certain subjects. The academic mentors are professors from the same school or different school who teach that specific subject, give extra time and support to students and help them prepare that specific subject.

OS Scribe Support:

The DSC in the past facilitated scribe support which is a writer for the student who because of certain disabilities need support in writing the answer paper in the examination. A Scribe is a person not from the same course and same batch.

Infrastructural Support:

The university has incorporated ramps and elevators to provide accessibility to those with physical disabilities.
