

O.P. Jindal Global University Access to Education Non-Discrimination Policy

POLICY CREATED IN: JANUARY 2017

Authority:

Approved by the Vice Chancellor of the OP Jindal Global University.

Applicability:

This policy applies to all individuals (irrespective of race, colour, caste, national or ethnic origin, sex, age, disability, religion, sexual orientation, gender identity or marital status) who want to pursue higher education at O.P. Jindal Global University post completion of secondary education from all boards acceptable under the existing government regulations and guidelines.

Admission:

O.P. Jindal Global University (JGU) admits eligible and qualified students of any race, color, caste, national or ethnic origin, sex, age, disability, religion, sexual orientation, gender identity or marital status to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the University.

Consistent with its obligations under the law, in the administration of JGU's programs and activities, JGU prohibits unlawful discrimination on the basis of race, colour, caste, national or ethnic origin, sex, age, disability, religion, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, marital status or any other characteristic protected by applicable law; JGU also prohibits unlawful harassment including but not limited to sexual harassment and sexual violence.

Access to education and information:

JGU does not discriminate in terms of access to education. Lectures, educational programmes and outreach events, vocational training or other lectures, training camps, conferences, workshops, seminars and others organized by JGU are available to all eligible and qualified participants of any race, colour, caste, national or ethnic origin, sex, age, disability, religion, sexual orientation, gender identity or marital status. This policy applies to JGU programs and activities both on and off-campus, including blended and online programs.
